Duties and Responsibilities

- Administering pain relief before, during, and after medical procedures
- Monitoring patients' vital signs during procedures
- Supervising anesthesia assistants and certified registered nurse anesthetists
- Approving general, sedative, regional, or local anesthetics
- Reviewing medical files and lab results
- Informing patients of risks associated with anesthesia
- Complying with medical and hospital procedure policy

Requirements for appointment

- Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery from an institution recognized by Medical practitioner and Dentist Board;
- Master's degree Anesthesia in or equivalent qualification from an institution recognized by the Medical Practitioners and Dentist Board.
- Certificate of registration by the medical practitioners and dentist board
- Valid practicing license from the medical practitioner and Dentists Board;
- Certificate in Computer Application skills from a recognized institution.
- Demonstrated professional competence and managerial capability as reflected in work performance and results.
