

## **1. CLINICAL OFFICER – Three (3) Posts**

Reporting to: CCC in charge and to the Clinical Officer in-charge

### **Overall Job Function**

The holder of the position is responsible for implementation of CCC clinical services including TB/HIV integration.

### **Duties and responsibilities:**

- Triage clients and establish health care needs daily and as necessary.

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- Provide HIV care to adults, adolescents and children based on the MoH guidelines and recommendation
- Assist with monitoring of HIV positive clients through blood work and physical assessment.
- To provide information and counseling to clients on prevention, adherence to HIV medication and clinic appointments
- Spearhead the provision of RH services within the HIV clinic ie Family planning and cervical cancer screening among others
- Provide TB/HIV care and mentor other HCWs on this
- Ensure RH services are offered including STI management and cervical cancer screening
- Assist with the maintenance of records on patients/clients.
- Ensure proper documentation in the various HIV care related tools as recommend by the MoH

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- Co-ordinate and participate in evidence based interventions
- Assist in coordinating community follow up of patients initiated on care and treatment;
- Train and supervise other health care professionals to assist in the provision of HIV care
- Maintain confidentiality of all activities to preserve dignity of patients, ensure accurate and secure documentation of activities;

### **Requirements:**

- Holders of a Basic Diploma in Clinical Medicine & Surgery from Kenya Medical Training College or any recognized institution.
- Those with ART Management and or Medical Counseling may also be considered( added advantage)

- At least three (3) years working experience after internship and must be registered with the Clinical Officers Council.
