

CHIEF MEDICAL LABORATORY OFFICER/ CHIEF MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGIST - JG 'M'– 10 POSTS

Duties and Responsibilities

- Implementing laboratory policies, guidelines, strategies and programs;
- Preparing media for culture and sensitivity testing;
- Requisitioning of laboratory consumables and apparatus;
- Investigating disease outbreaks in liaison with other health care providers;
- Archiving specimens of medical importance for reference;
- Mentoring and coaching trainees on practical attachments;
- Coordinating the preparation of reagents, strains and examining specimens;
- Verifying and approving results;
- Screening for blood transfusion transmissible infections;
- Preparing blood products;
- Preparing operational research proposals;
- Supervising the disinfection, washing and sterilization of apparatus;
- Maintaining equipment and reagents for vector and insecticides, application, Monitoring and evaluation;
- Preparing periodical reports;
- Validating and calibrating equipment.

Requirements for Appointment (Diploma holders)

- Served in the grade of Senior Medical Laboratory Technologists for a minimum period of three (3) years;
- Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences or any other equivalent qualification from an institution recognized by Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians and Technologists Board;
- Registration Certificate issued by Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians and Technologists Board (KMLTTB);
- Valid practicing license from Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians and Technologists Board;
- Certificate in supervisory skills course not lasting less than two (2) weeks from a recognized institution;
- Certificate in computer application skills from a recognized institution;

- Shown in merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results.

Requirements for Appointment (Degree holders)

- Served in the grade of Chief Medical laboratory Technologist for minimum period of three (3) years;
- Bachelors in Medical laboratory Sciences or any other equivalent qualification from an institution recognized by Kenya Medical Laboratory technicians and Technologists Board;
- Registration certificate issued by the Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians and Technologists Board (KMLTTB);
- Valid practicing license from Kenya Medical Laboratory Technicians and Technologists Board;
- Certificate in computer application from a recognized institution;
- Shown initiative and competence in planning, organizing work and discharging medical laboratory functions.
