

**PRINCIPAL PHYSIOTHERAPIST /PRINCIPAL REGISTERED  
PHYSIOTHERAPIST - JG 'N' – 1 POST**

**Duties and Responsibilities**

- Treating and rehabilitating patient/clients using physiotherapist interventions i.e. electrotherapy, manipulative therapy/technology, exercise therapy among others in clinical areas and the community;
- Planning and organizing group physiotherapist treatment/sessions for patients and clients;
- Evaluating treatment outcomes for reviews, placement, referral or discharge;
- Carrying out physical disability assessment for categorization;
- Registration and other support;
- Providing health promotion and education to patients/clients on neuro musculoskeletal disorders and health living to prevent non communicable diseases;
- Maintaining information and records relating to patients;
- Inducting students in practical training on physiotherapist therapy services
- Requisition and ensuring availability of physiotherapist supplies and equipment as well as giving support and health education to patients and relatives in hospital.
- Maintaining equipment and inventory;
- Analyzing data for research and preparing reports;
- Coaching and mentoring of staff;

**Requirements for Appointment (Diploma holders)**

- For appointment to this grade an officer must have: -
- Served in the grade of registered chief physiotherapist for a minimum of three (3) years;
- Diploma in physiotherapy from a recognized institution;
- Certificate in supervisory skills course lasting not less than two (2) weeks from a recognized institution;
- Certificate in computer application skills from a recognized institution;
- Show merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results;
- Certificate of registration from the Kenya Society of physiotherapists (KSP);
- Current certificate of practice from the Kenya society of physiotherapists (KPS)

### **Requirements for Appointment (Degree holders)**

- Served in the grade of chief physiotherapist for a minimum period of three (3) years;
- Bachelor's Degree in physiotherapy from a recognized institution;
- Certificate in senior management course lasting not less than four (4) weeks from a recognized institution;
- Certificate in computer application skills from a recognized institution;
- Show merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results;
- Certificate of registration from the Kenya Society of physiotherapists (KSP);
- Current certificate of practice from the Kenya society of physiotherapists (KPS)
