

**(i) SENIOR SUPERVISORS (8 POSITIONS)**

For appointment as a Senior Supervisor, a candidate must:

- a) Have minimum academic qualification of a Degree from a recognized University preferably in Agricultural Sciences, Statistics, Social Sciences, Community Development and any other related disciplines
