

WARD-BASED SUPERVISORS (35 POSITIONS)

For appointment as a Ward-Based Supervisors, a candidate must:

- a) Have minimum academic qualification of a Degree from a recognized University preferably in Agricultural Sciences, Statistics, Social Sciences, Community Development and any other related disciplines.

- d) Be identified from county government staff. Consideration will be given to the civil servants in the county.
- e) Be currently working in the target Ward
- f) Having participated in similar exercises and experience on extension and data collection will be an added advantage

These supervisors will supervise and backstop Assistant Ward-based supervisors during baseline/routine data collection.
