INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Murang'a County Government Internship Program is a government youth programme whose main objective is to offer college graduates the opportunity to gain hands on experience and build skills in order to enhance their chances for employment, networking and entrepreneurship.

Murang'a County Public Service Board wishes to recruit competent and qualified persons as interns under the county internship programme in different specializations as indicated below:

2. REGISTERED NURSES INTERNS- THIRTY (30) posts

Requirements for appointment

- (i) Diploma in any of the following disciplines: Kenya Registered Community Health Nursing, Kenya Registered Nursing, Kenya Registered Midwifery, Kenya Registered Nursing/Midwifery or Kenya Registered Nursing/Mental Health and Psychiatry from a recognized institution;
- (ii) Registration Certificate issued by the Nursing Council of Kenya; and
- (iii) Valid practicing license from the Nursing Council of Kenya;
- (iv) Be aged 35 years and below.

Duties and Responsibilities

This is an entry and training grade for this cadre. An officer at this level will work under the guidance of a senior officer. Duties and responsibilities at this level will entail:

- (i) Assessing, planning, implementing nursing interventions and evaluating patient's outcomes;
- (ii) Providing appropriate healthcare services including Integrated Management Of Childhood Illnesses (IMCI), Immunization, PMTCT, Ante-Natal Care and Delivery, Providing Health Education and Counselling to patients/clients and community on identified health needs;
- (iii) Referring patients and clients appropriately;
- (iv) Facilitating patients' admission and initiating discharge plans;
- (v) Maintaining records on patients'/clients health condition and care;
- (vi) Ensuring a tidy and safe clinical environment; and
- (vii) Collecting and compiling data.
